

Anupam Neog, Dipota Poultry Farm, Tezpur

In the year 1989, Dr. Kanak Ch. Sarma the then District A. H. & Veterinary Officer, Sonitpur, had helped me with technical guidance to rear poultry and also showed me the Govt. Poultry farm, Tezpur, which inspired me to start a poultry farm on my own.

In the year 1990, being an unemployed youth, I started a poultry farm at Dipota with a capital of Rs. 12,000/-, which was given to me by my elder sister. I have not taken any bank loan or financial assistance from the Govt.

At the beginning, I started the farm with 300 nos. of broiler chicks and one farmhouse. Now I have a farm in an area of 8 katha land, 10 farm houses, 6 employees including one manager and five workers.

Now, the farm has a capacity of rearing 4000 chicks per month. My monthly expenditure on feed, chicks and medicines, management and wages is about Rs. 1,35,000/- to Rs. 1,65,000/-. Now I have a monthly profit margin of Rs. 18,000/- to 20,000/-. I am supplying poultry meat to S.S.B. Army and to various hotels. Extending my venture, I do also supply chick and poultry feed in and around Tezpur.
